Who founded The Dereham Blues Festival? Doreen & Stewart Aitken, who first ran the festival in 2013.

Who plays at the festival?

50+ acts drawn from all over the UK, including a large from Norfolk.

Who goes to the festival?

Several thousand people visit The Dereham Blues Festival every year from all over the country. It is popular with everyone from aficionados to families with young children – and everyone in between!

Who runs the festival?

The festival is run by volunteers as a not-for-profit company.

What are the aims of The Dereham Blues Festival?

To keep blues music alive in East Anglia and to provide a platform for a range of blues acts to play to an increasing fanbase.

To create an inclusive and fun event for the whole town and the wider region to enjoy whilst promoting Dereham as a great place to visit.

What venues do blues acts play during The Dereham Blues Festival?

Over 12 town centre venues play host, including bars, pubs, cafes, the local cricket club and the train station – entry to these venues is free of charge.

Who chooses the bands to play?

A small team of volunteers choose from the bands who have applied to play at the next festival. They use their knowledge of blues to allocate bands to particular venues.

How is the headline act chosen?

The opening concert is organised by the Friends of Dereham Memorial Hall whose chairman chooses the headline artist in conjunction with the festival committee members.

What does the festival do for Dereham? The market town of Dereham has seen significant growth over the past few years and the blues festival reflects and supports this social and economic development. The 2000+ visitors provide a real economic boost to the town and its businesses.

What are the origins of The Dereham Blues Festival? The festival grew out of the vibrant Norfolk Blues Society which has been going for 8 years, and was also founded by Doreen & Stewart Aitken.

Where is Dereham and how do I get there? Dereham is 16 miles west of Norwich and 30 miles east of King's Lynn, just off the A47. Buses run to the centre of Dereham from Norwich And King's Lynn on a regular basis.

How do the bands get paid?


The hosting venues pay a fee to the bands for playing at that venue. Large audiences visit most venues.

How long do the bands play for and when?

On average, each band plays an hour-long set. Depending on the programme, bands move around the venues and play several over the course of the week.
